A message from staff

Being humble, trust worthy, encouraging, selfless, loving, strong, patient (and whole lot of it), compassionate, steadfast and consistent. These are just a few words that describe who I need to be to do my job at Ramoth. My name is Leah Pronk. I have been with Ramoth House since April of 2018, but as of September I have joined the lead team as House manager. Full time in the home with our mom's day in and day out, Monday to Friday. This job has been a true answer to prayers. I came to Ramoth House fresh out of University seeking a job or experience in my field and God led me to join a team who is so committed to raising young women up, to teach them how to reach their parenting potential and loving each mom and baby who walk through those doors with the unconditional love that is centered on Christ. I am not going to lie to you, being with the moms and their babies every day isn't easy; I have cried, wept, sang, and jumped for joy alongside these women. I ride the roller coaster of emotions, steps forward and steps backwards each mother takes here at Ramoth. Yet, God always knows best and currently he is teaching me humility. I don't know the first thing about being a mom; I don't know the right or the wrong thing to do in every situation and most of the time I do make things up on the spot. Humility teaches us to find rest in confessing that we can't do it all, that "I am not enough and I need help". Humility leads us to our brokenness. But humility also teaches us that God is actively redeeming this world. That's what we are trying to do here at Ramoth, showing others Christ. Our mom's and babies come in often with so much hurt and brokenness. They need to know that there is someone beside them broken as well, but still willing to love them unconditionally even if they don't know it is in Christ Alone.
